#### Steam Locomotive Builders Plates & Number Boards

- Steam locomotives have always been identified with the name of their builders by means of a metal plate mounted on each side of the smoke boxes.
- They were cast in all shapes and sizes, in various types of metals, with the name of the locomotive builder, serial number, location of the company, and year date of completion.
- Steam locomotive number boards have always been used to identify the number of the Steam Locomotive.
- They were cast in all shapes and sizes, metal, glass, plastic, with the number of the locomotive.
- Front number boards were mounted above or below the locomotive headlight.
- Side number boards were mounted on each side of the locomotive headlight.
