
Directions to the shops:

Take Rte. 3 to the Rte. 129 exit (N.Billerica). Follow 129 as it joins with Rte. 3A south. Where Rte.129 and 3A diverge, bear to the extreme left at the three way intersection. (3A goes straight,, 129 to the left, and your road to the far left). Follow to a package store on the right and turn right onto High St. Continue on High St. about $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile until you reach the Iron Horse Park on your right. Go all the way down the road ~~#####~~ through the park to the parking lot in front of the B&M buildings. (There is even a new sign up). See you there.

The other date to remember is April 14. The Boston chapter of the NRHS is sponsoring a railroad show at the Newton Highlands Congregation~~al~~ Church on April 14 and 15, including a dinner on the evening of the 15th, and movies on both evenings.
